Mechanics are responsible for the care and maintenance of all District vehicles and apparatus. The District currently has 13 Emergency Apparatus vehicles and 16 District vehicles in their fleet.

### **DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Under the supervision of the Operations Deputy Chief provides management, maintenance, and repair of the District fleet and related areas
- Plans and coordinates fleet maintenance and repairs, including the determination of out-of-service criteria, warranty compliance, and negotiation of sublet repairs.
- Responsible for fleet compliance of ISO, NFPA, EPA and state vehicular safety requirements
- Prepare, maintain, and submit records and reports
- Additional duties/responsibilities listed in job description

- Required previous experience in maintaining Emergency and/or Heavy Equipment
- Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Medium/Heavy Duty Truck Technician certificate
